-ing form of verb

The **-ing** form of verb indicates an action which is in progress/ happening at the time of speaking.

Rules 1: we add **-ing** in the end of a verb.:

Eg: sing	singing
do	doing
buy	buying
play	Playing
jump	Jumping
listen	Listening
look	looking
see	seeing
meet	meeting

Rule:2 if the word ends in **e** ,drop **e** and add **-ing**

Eg: bake	baking
make	making
take	taking
game	gaming
write	writing
like	liking
wake	waking

Rule 3: If the word ends with a **consonant** but the second last letter is a **vowel**, double the last letter and add – **ing**.

Eg:

swim	swimming
get	getting
put	putting
hop	hopping
shop	shopping
run	running
cut	cutting
sit	sitting
skip	skipping
travel	travelling
dig	digging
