

Measurement of Length:

Points to Remember:

we use parts of our body like **finger**, **handspan**, **cubits** and **paces** to measure things .these are called non standard units.



The standard units to measure length are:

a) To measure short lengths ,we use a unit called **centimetre**.

eg: length of a pencil.

We write centimetre as **cm** .

b) To measure long lengths , we use a unit called metre .

eg: length of a black board.





We write **metre** as **m**. $100 \text{ cm} = 1 \text{ m}$

c) To measure long distances, we use a unit called **kilometers**.

We write **kilometres** as **km**. eg: distance between two places.


