International System of Numeration

In the International System of Numeration, as it being used we have ones, tens, hundreds, thousands and then millions. One million is a thousand thousands. We put commas after every three digits from the right. First comma marks thousands and the next commas marks millions.

For Example 50,801,592 is read in the International System as Fifty million eight hundred one thousand five hundred ninety two. In Indian System 5,08,01,592 it is five Crore eight lakh one thousand five hundred ninety two. Now Do Exercise sums.
