- Ans. E-commerce stands for electronic commerce. Electronic Commerce (or EC) is the buying and selling of goods and services on the Internet. The payment for items purchased is made by using the Electronic Fund Transfer (EFT).

There a variety of E-commerce applications. Some of these are:

- 1. Retail stores such as music stores, book stores and toy stores selling items.
- 2. Banks providing services such as EFT, giving information on account status, etc.
- 3. Cinema halls, airlines making tickets available online and accepting payment through credit/debit cards.

- Ans. E-government is an abbreviation for Electronic government. E-government is a general term describing the use of various technologies to make possible the operations of the government, and about the information and services provided by a government. Some of its features are:
 - 1. Payment of telephone, electricity and other kinds of bills online.
 - 2. The availability of government forms (passport forms, driving licensing issue/renewal forms) online.
 - 3. Submission of the forms and inquiry for passport and driving licenses.
