Worksheet 5: Answer in one word/sentence.

- Q. 1. Which tool lets us scale rotate and skew our shapes?
Ans. Free Transform tool.
- Q. 2. What is the component that consists division of frames arranged on a numbered grid called?
Ans. Timeline.
- Q. 3. What is the workspace in Flash known as?
Ans. Stage.
- Q. 4. What happens when we use Break Apart command twice on a text string?
Ans. It is broken into its components (fills and lines).
- Q. 5. Which tool is used to select the stroke colour and change the colour, width and style of the lines drawn and outlines?
Ans. Ink bottle tool.
- Q. 6. What is the use of Faucet mode in Eraser tool?
Ans. WE can erase by using the Faucet mode, in which we simply click on the object to erase it completely.
- Q. 7. What is a Frame?
Ans. A Frame is a single step of animation or a picture on the Flash timeline.

- Q. 1. Write about the Flash software.
Ans. The Flash software is used to develop interactive graphics and animations which can be used on a website or for any other multimedia purpose. Flash elements can include simple text, buttons, scrolling text, slide show pictures and animations embedded with sound. Flash is extremely well suited for creating content that can be delivered over the Internet because its files are very small in size.
- Q. 2. Write about the Timeline.
Ans. The Timeline consists of division of frames arranged on a numbered grid. It contains the sequence of images (in frames) which make the animation.
- Q. 3. Write about the Rectangle and Oval tools.
Ans. Using the Rectangle tool you can draw rectangles and squares.
Using the Oval tool, you can draw circles and ovals.
- Q. 4. What is the use of the free Transform tool?
Ans. The Free Transform tool lets you scale, rotate and skew your shapes.
- Q. 5. Write down difference between Ink bottle tool and Paint bucket tool.
Ans. Using the Ink Bottle tool, you can select the stroke colour and change the colour, width and style of the lines drawn and outlines.
Using the Paint Bucket tool, you can select Fill colour and fill it in any closed shape or change the already filled area.
