

Schools are closed, and it's holiday time, once again-and it is fun and frolic all the way. Yet, that does not mean that the doors of learning are closed. Remember that any activity can be an interesting learning experience enriches his or her experience of life.

With a little care and attention, parents can make vacation days really memorable. First and foremost on the list, of course, are games. Prepare any two stick puppets of your favourite fruit, vegetable animal, bird or cartoon character. All parents need to do is to watch over them and help them with their little hands.

 To help the child be independent-teach them to tie shoe lace, button their clothes and also to keep themselves neat and clean, to put their toy, clothes and personal belongings in their proper place. With these basic instructions we are sure they will learn more discipline.
