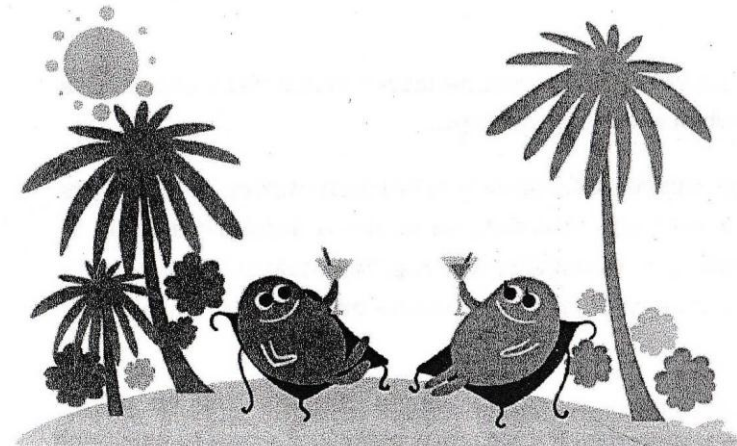

- While travelling on the road, the child may be asked to count numbers of red and white coloured cars. Take your Child along with you for shopping fruits and vegetables. Tell its names in English.

- The child should know his/her name, class, father's name/mother's name, telephone number and address.

Opportunities to combine play with learning are many. Children by nature are inventive and imaginative, and they will themselves come up with novel ideas to occupy their mind in a creative way. All parents need to do is to watch over them and give them lots of support.

- To help the child be independent-teach them to tie shoe lace, button their clothes and also to keep themselves neat and clean, to put their toy, clothes and personal belongings in their proper place. With these basic instructions we are sure they will learn more discipline.
