Tropical Evergreen Forests	Deciduous Forests
<p>(i) These forests are also known as Tropical Rain Forests.</p> <p>(ii) These forests do not shed their leaves.</p> <p>(iii) These forests are found in areas receiving more than 200 cm of annual rainfall.</p> <p>(iv) Ebony, Mahogany and Rosewood are typical trees of these forests.</p>	<p>(i) These forests are also known as Monsoon forests.</p> <p>(ii) These forests shed their leaves during summer.</p> <p>(iii) These forests are found in areas receiving annual rainfall between 70-200 cm.</p> <p>(iv) Teak, sal, sandal are important trees of these forests.</p>
